## PER ACETIC ACID (5% & 15%)

Colourless, liquid, with Pungent odour

Completely miscible with water

### NATURE OF HAZARD :

Corrosive

Heating will cause pressure rise severe risk of bursting and explosion Reaction with combustible substances oils fats or impurities generates heat and may cause fire and explosion.

The substance increases fire risk contaminated or combustible material e.g. Clothing ignites more readily. Contact with liquid causes skinburns and severe damage to eyes.

### PROTECTIVE DEVICES :

Goggles giving complete protection to eyes. Plastic gloves, apron and boots, Eyewash bottle with clean water.

### EMERGENCY ACTION :

Notify Police and Fire Brigade immediately. If possible move vehicle to open ground. Stop the engine, No naked lights, No smoking, Mark roads and warn other road users, Keep public away from danger area.

### SPILLAGE :

Drench with water. If substance has entered a water course or sewer or contaminated soil or vegetation, advice Police. Do not absorb in sawdust or other combustible materials. Do not use Iron containers for spilled liquid, use plastic, aluminum or stainless steel containers.

### FIRE :

Keep containers cool by spraying with water and Extinguish with water. Do not use dry chemical or foam keep upwind. If temperature reaches above 84°C, the vapors can catch fire.

### FIRST AID :

If substance has got into the eyes, immediately wash out with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing immediately and wash affected skin with plenty of water. Seek medical treatment when anyone has symptoms apparently due to swallowing or contact with skin or eyes.
